

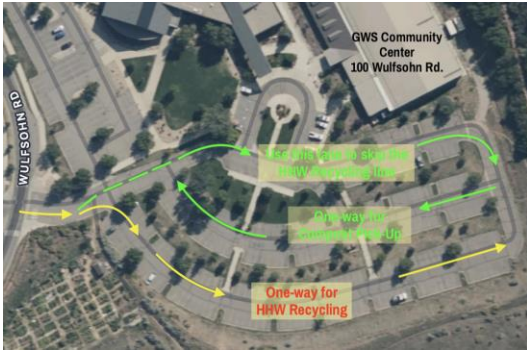
# Happy Spring!

Saturday, April 20th at 9am  
- Glenwood Springs

Front parking lot of Basalt Middle School. Enter the second driveway off of School St. Check in and park on either side of the compost pile.

Aspen CMC campus parking lot at 255 Sage Way. Immediate right after entering parking lot. **We look forward to seeing you!**



## Yard Waste Reminder

Yard waste is a welcome component to compost, but there are many rules to follow when setting it out for pick-up. The list can be found on our [Curbside Yard Waste webpage](#). Bucket customers are allowed 1 extra bag/bin each week. [Upon request, we can deliver our recommended paper lawn bags](#). If you have more yard waste, it is cost efficient to [upgrade to cart service](#) or use a [local drop-off center](#).

## Yard Waste Rules

- Bags & bins must be less than 30-gallons and less than 30-lbs.
- Any extra bags or bins past allowance are an extra \$5 each.
- We will not pick-up loose materials or service plastic bags.

## Be Bear Smart

- Buckets are not bear-proof, only set them out on service days.
- Have all food waste in buckets or carts; unprotected compost attracts birds & beasts.
