As everyone who lives in our community can attest, this is a special place. More specifically I want to ensure that we spend our collective money as prudently as possible, that our efforts in the next two years set us up for success over the next twenty, and that these improvements don't result in financial burdens for homeowners in the future. In short: if we greatly enhance our amenities and facilities, but double our dues, then we have failed.

Professionally, I have over a decade of experience working in clean energy - I'm currently a Senior Product Marketing Manager at Uplight, a software firm based in Boulder (I work from an

office in Coventure on Main St.). I have significant experience in project budgeting and delivery, facilitation and stakeholder management, and communications.
