

**HELP US ELIMINATE A PESKY, POLLUTING PROBLEM:**  
*RVR Residents are REQUIRED to clean up pet waste.*



- Dog poop should be picked up promptly when out walking.
- Owners/tenants should be sure to maintain their yards regularly to keep them free of dog poop from their own pet(s).

Dog feces pose a variety of health risks and are very unpleasant to all residents using the walking paths for recreation or enjoying their yard.

Poop bags are provided year round at the regularly serviced waste stations. So, please, be a good neighbor (and pooch parent) and scoop it up!

**Suggestions for effectively resolving a pet issue with your Neighbor**

1. **Pick up after your dog and even scoop some of those piles that may not be from your pooch!** (Good Karma!)

2. **Communication** – Using the “Good Neighbor Policy” is the best, first approach to dealing with a problem. Talk to your neighbors and inform them of the matter and that they are in violation of our Covenants and the Town of Carbondale Code.

3. **Call the Executive Director** – If you cannot resolve the issue directly with your neighbor, please contact the Executive Director, Ian Hause, via email or telephone. Please have as many facts as possible. The more current and accurate the report is, the more effective the RVRMA or Town of Carbondale Police will be in enforcement. ***All reports and complaints are kept confidential by the RVRMA.***

3. **Call the Carbondale Police Department** –The CPD non-emergency telephone number is 970-963-2662. Use this option if it is **after normal business hours and at night.**
